## **About Us: A New Leaf Publications**

### The Publishing Division

Maybe you've heard reference to ANLP during a District Service Committee (DSC) meeting or at the annual Conference. You've probably thought, another acronym, really? What is ANLP, anyway?

<u>A New Leaf Publications</u> (ANLP) is the publishing division of Marijuana Anonymous. A New Leaf Publications publishes the following materials: the <u>Life with Hope</u> book and workbook, MA pamphlets, the Service Manual, New Meeting Starter Kits, and soon, the <u>Living Every Day with Hope</u> daily meditation book that was recently approved by the MA World Service Conference body.

The ANLP staff includes the following trusted servant positions: Chairperson, Treasurer, Secretary, Content Editor, and Design Editor, as well as a paid special worker, the ANLP Office Administrator.

### The Newsletter

A New Leaf (ANL) is the literary newsletter for Marijuana Anonymous. A New Leaf newsletter is similar to the AA Grapevine magazine. ANL contains MA <u>member-submitted stories</u> and other creative expressions sharing experience, strength, and hope in recovery. It also publishes <u>sobriety birthdays</u> when MA members submit them individually or through their district ANLP Bureau Chief. A New Leaf also provides announcements and updates about major MA events and the ongoing work of MA World Services committees.

Members who would like to <u>subscribe</u> to *A New Leaf* may purchase an annual subscription for the print version that is delivered to their home. Starting next month, members will also be able to separately subscribe to receive the literary newsletter digitally, as well.

What *A New Leaf* newsletter is not - *Carry the Message*! [] All the love for *Carry the Message*, which is a service-based, free digital enewsletter, but they aren't the same. *A New Leaf* is a paid literary publication that carries stories of experience, strength, and hope directly from members. MA members who are familiar with Alcoholics Anonymous could liken it to *The Grapevine*, AA's paid subscription literary magazine.

Besides collecting content, designing, printing, and delivering *A New Leaf* literary newsletter, A New Leaf Publications manages the contract with Hazelden, which prints the 3rd edition of *Life with Hope*, as well as the workbook. All other printed materials, like the Service Manual and New Meeting Starter Kits, are processed through A New Leaf Publications.

# ANLP ADMINISTRATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

The ANLP Administrator supports the efforts of the A New Leaf Publications board and fulfills A New Leaf orders. A great administrator has excellent organization and time management skills, is able to operate efficiently without supervision, and communicates effectively in both writing and over the phone. The ideal candidate will be adept at fulfillment procedures and will be able to actively discover new ways to perform the job more efficiently.

### Qualifications

Minimum two years of sobriety from marijuana, alcohol, and all self-prescribed mind-altering chemicals.

Working knowledge of the Marijuana Anonymous Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts for Service

A resident of the United States, with access to a home office or similar facilities, with the ability to receive deliveries as needed Ability to maintain flexible office hours and attend meetings on weekends with occasional weekday evenings

Ability to operate efficiently without on-site supervision

Strong typing skills with the ability to communicate effectively in writing, on the phone, and digitally

Ongoing access to a high-speed internet connection

Ability to effectively use the software systems employed by ANLP such as Google, eCommerce, Adobe Suites, Zoom, etc.

#### **Responsibilities (in order of priority)**

Process ANLP orders received using eCommerce software

Place printed orders in a timely manner in order to reduce delivery delays Picks up, packs, and ships orders

Receive, store, and account for inventory

Monitor incoming communications; respond or redirect as appropriate

Perform other related duties as assigned by the Board Chair

Maintain on-site storage for inventory and equipment

(approximately 5' x 5' cubic area)

Participate in, at minimum, semi-annual performance reviews
