Life with Hope Book & Workbook Ordering... Update!

On September 21, 2019 Marijuana Anonymous World Services entered an agreement licensing Hazelden Publishing to publish and distribute current and future Englishlanguage editions of the Life with Hope (LwH) book and workbook. All books, workbooks, the A New Leaf newsletter and other service materials may still be ordered MA's A New Leaf Publications website, www.anewleafpublications.org, but orders for the LwH book and workbook (only) will be redirected to the Hazelden website for payment, fulfillment and shipping by Hazelden.

Pricing for the current 3rd edition of the *LwH* book and the current 1st edition of the workbook remains the same. Under the agreement, Hazelden has also been authorized to produce new re-designed editions of both the book and the workbook, anticipated for release in April 2020.

This is exciting news for our fellowship! And, it is a much anticipated aid in meeting our "primary purpose" under Tradition Five: "to carry its message to the marijuana addict who still suffers". It is envisioned that the agreement will not only provide both greater exposure of MA literature through Hazelden's extensive marketing network, but also provide greater income to MA from sales of *Life with Hope*.

The purpose of *A New Leaf* is to carry the message of recovery from marijuana addiction. It is through the written experiences of recovering addicts and their stories that we may find experience, strength and hope.

MAWS Treasurer's Report

I am the current Treasurer for Marijuana Anonymous World Services (MAWS). I volunteer about 12 hours time per month performing the variety of services set out in the MA Service Manual (pp. 55-56). Below is the summary report I provided to MA Delegates for the 1st quarter of fiscal year 2019-2020.

Marijuana Anonymous World Services (MAWS) has a substantial financial reserve due to the fact that for a number of years we did not have any special workers. The lack of these workers resulted in major problems, especially in fulfillment of ANLP orders and maintaining our legal compliance with the responsibilities of an incorporated non-profit organization. Over the past few years, these problems have been fixed as the MAWS Board of Trustees and A New Leaf Publications (ANLP) have worked hard to bring our organization into compliance and have prompt and efficient fulfillment of ANLP orders.

Currently, our special workers consist of an accountant, assistant

accountant, a webmaster and an office administrator. As a result, we are now spending more money than we are bringing in, and our Treasurer has pointed out that this level of deficit spending cannot be sustained indefinitely. The MAWS Board of Trustees plans to initiate additional fundraising efforts throughout our Fellowship to increase our income.

Below is a general summary of MAWS' income and expenses for approximately the first quarter of fiscal year 2019-2020. As can be seen, we have a net deficit for this time period. MAWS still has some financial reserves, but this level of discrepancy cannot be maintained indefinitely. I am encouraging all MA members to consider making regular contributions to MAWS (Any amount helps!), which can be done through the PayPal link on the MAWS website. Many people and groups already do (as can be seen from the ~5k in 7th tradition, but it will take a bit more to keep us running smoothly).




